WOBURN, MA-The Massachusetts Amateur Sports Foundation (MASF) will be holding the 2006 Bay State Summer Games July 10-23. 2006 marks the 25th anniversary of the Games, which offers 25 sports to athletes of all ages and abilities. Opportunities to compete in the Games are available for a wide variety of ages and skill levels. Eastern Massachusetts is the home to the first weekend of finals July 10-16, while Central MA plays host to the festival sports and ice hockey July 17-23.

Competitions take place at 17 different venues across Eastern and Central Massachusetts at which volunteers are needed.
